In addition, we have been focusing on ecology and innovation for several years by digitalising everything as much as possible (less printing, electronic invoicing, electronic pay slips, electronic archiving, digital meetings to limit trips between our locations, etc.), and concentrating on an eco-friendly car fleet for our staff. Our clients are at the heart of our services and we are always looking for solutions to answer their questions as quickly and efficiently as possible. We also consider it important to contribute financially to various social projects such as "De Warmste Week" or to the United Fund for Belgium.



As part of a global network, Deloitte Legal is committed to positively contribute to a more sustainable world. Based on our carbon footprint, we decided to first address the areas where we could greatly improve our environmental impact: mobility, travel, and infrastructure. We incentivized our employees to adopt sustainable mobility alternatives, both for their daily commutes and for international meetings. We are working on reducing CO2 emissions produced by our buildings, indeed downsizing from four buildings to one in Brussels in 2017 means that the CO2 consumption of the new premises is no less than 40% lower. But we aim to go further and to



produce 40% of our own renewable energy compared to total consumption in Belgium by 2023 and 100% by 2030.

- We have installed LED lamps in our offices.

- The sorting of paper is done via containers, the paper is then confidentially recycled.
- We have installed a shower, so that our staff can come by bike, electric scooter, electric bike etc...
- We have agreed to flexible hours to minimize travel during peak hours.
- Teleworking is also accepted for our employees.

The environment remains a priority for our firm and we try every day to make our staff aware of their responsibilities in this matter.
